

TYPHOON AWARENESS

Okinawa typhoon season runs between June to November and 25% of Okinawa's annual rain fall is brought by typhoons. Most typhoon occur during July, August, and September. Typhoons can be very powerful and destructive, although similar to hurricanes they rarely reach the same level of force as the similar Atlantic storms. It's best to stay indoors during a typhoon in Okinawa to avoid injury or death from flying debris. If a typhoon occurs English language Typhoon information can be found on military weather radio stations 648 AM and 89.1FM.

***It is your responsibility to bring all items inside such as a satellite dish, trash cans and anything that can cause damage during a typhoon. If damaged is caused, tenant will be charged for the cost of repair.**
